<u>PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH:</u> Physical Education and Health is a specialist area and students have 1-2 lessons a week learning specific sports, movement, co-ordination and components of the Health curriculum. Play Is The Way is also heavily featured in these lessons.

MUSIC/THE ARTS: Music is a specialist area and all classes have a music lesson each week.

CHOIR: The school has a Senior choir for Year 5-7 which is involved in the Festival of Music.
